Missions Grants

This month I'd like to reintroduce a program the association introduced last year. It has been mentioned, but we need to remind people of it, so it gets taken advantage of. We have made a grant proposal for mission work in our local churches that is funded by our Association's funds. At present you may have noticed that we don't do a lot as an association. Part of that is the natural changes that have come over the years as National resources and State Convention resources have become more easily accessed at a local level. Part is also related to our ongoing efforts to find work that unites us and meets needs we can't meet more effectively elsewhere. Finally, it reinforces the idea that it is **CHURCHES** that are the body of Christ! The association can help but should not replace the church as the primary source of Christian activity!

So, while there are several other things that are ongoing, we'd like you to use the grant program that allows us to use the association's resources to help churches send people on mission. The plan is to make available each year a part of our held finances on a first-come, first-served basis. We are planning on at least \$10,000 - \$20,000 total association wide annually. Starting this year we are including a \$10,000 line item. Each Church would be limited to a certain amount. And each individual per year as well. Financially we are looking for ways to reinvest in our churches and this looks to be a great way for several reasons.

First, it will be church based. Each missionary will need their churches approval on the application and be through a church approved venture. We are here to support **YOUR Church's** efforts to obey the Great Commission. This will leave the church in charge, and responsible for finding, and scheduling trips. Our role is to help make those possible through prayer and funding.

Secondly, we hope it is responsible financial stewardship. We are not a savings and loan institute; we are Christians obeying the great commission. As such our efforts are in support of the local churches, and that should include our financial efforts — we don't need to accumulate as an association — we need to be investing in the Kingdom as churches! We are as an Association are currently surpassing our expenses with a reserve of roughly 150,000. It is hoped that it will be a means of reminding churches that giving to the association is a means of giving to local churches that are in need.

Finally, we want to see people going, and share in those stories. It seems that so many people struggle to make the time, much less the financial commitment to go on missions. It may be Disaster Relief, Evangelism, Construction, whatever the church is led to accomplish. But as an association, we want your church to know we are there to support you and help you go!
