Praying Together

Last month we met at Thaxton for an association wide prayer time for missions. It involved half a dozen ministries, some local, some international. They each presented their mission and we had a few moments of prayer over each endeavor. Thaxton and Pastor Ethan Strickler did a great job hosting us. It is this type of cooperation we seek. Where churches encourage each other to the larger job of service for our Lord and building His Kingdom. Often it seems that Churches have a mindset that is focused around their own numbers with little regard to the broader Kingdom, unless it is a means to their own growth. But we are truly a part of something eternal and it is important to always have that in perspective.

Baptist churches have long prided themselves on their independence. That can be a good thing when it is a Biblically warranted responsibility to be accountable in the local church for our elders and deacons, our ministries, our missionaries, and local communities. We need to know we are responsible participants in the kingdom in our neighborhood so that we remain focused on our contributions and responsibilities.

But we can also grow inwardly focused and neglect that we are responsible for obeying the great commission and for encouraging and aiding other local churches. So, while we may avoid financial entanglements and influences by local autonomy, we are commanded to go to the nations. The examples in the book of Acts and the Epistles are that we are in this together and ought to be encouraging and edifying each other beyond lip service.

Fellowship and communication become essential for churches being built up and are Biblically demonstrated throughout the New Testament simply by the fact that much of it consists of letters to other churches! So pray for each other and join us in getting to know each other that we might advance the Kingdom of our Lord together!
