On-Mission for Him

It is an exciting year for the SBA! We have already helped in sending out over a dozen people to the mission field! In addition, we are hoping to get churches involved in praying with each other and for each other. I pray that you share this excitement! Another possibility that is in prayer is sharing resources for equipping type weekend collaborations.

The need to work together is often misunderstood as doing everything together. As in, if you are to help another church you must do their projects and go on their trips. This can be overwhelming for a small church that is struggling to accomplish things in their own communities. It can also seem a distraction to churches large enough that they do not 'need' the association or other churches to stay busy. In seeking an interaction of value to all the churches of all sizes I'd like to remind us of the conference in Jerusalem.

In Acts 15 Paul and Barnabas came before the Apostles to deal with accusations that the gentile churches needed to submit to circumcision. At the end of the debating the message was returned to the churches with an encouragement to remain pure in several matters, and the message to churches was recognizing that God's Holy Spirit was active among them. So, the support to the churches became messengers calling each other to faithfulness and encouraging them in their work! My desire is to see us as an association, calling each other to fidelity to God's Word, and encouraging each other in the work of building God's kingdom! Let us rejoice in each other's successes and encourage each other by them.

In accordance with that goal I'd like to encourage you with a different mindset about the success of the church. Often it is the size of the church body that is seen. Sometimes, it is the building. When those become our metrics, the world – and too many of our own, draw a false conclusion about the power of the church. We instead ought to be reminded that God is the author of faith, our sustainer, and ultimately the one who builds His church – His bride. And God will make it beautiful in its time. Our churches are outposts meant to point to our King – remember, we are ambassadors! We are in a world hostile to God but represent a King more powerful than all He created. Focus on how powerful God is. He sustains, He builds, He saves! Encourage one another that we are on the same side, with the same awesome God working all things for His glory. And when God blesses one of us, all benefit, we are not alone, and should never settle for even the appearance of being alone, but always in cooperation in support of God's work through each of our congregations.




