From our Constitution & Bylaws - the Administrative Team is composed of the Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Secretary, Treasurer, and Clerk. The Administrative Team usually meets on a quarterly basis, or as needed, to handle any Business of the Association between Meetings of the Leadership Team and the Annual Meeting. The Leadership Team is composed of the Officers of the Association, the Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Secretary, Treasurer, and Clerk, Plus the Pastor and 1 elected representative, or messenger, from each Church. The Duties of the Leadership Team is to conduct the business of the Association between the Annual Meetings. The SBA Leadership Team met Tuesday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 pm, at Trinity Baptist Church to conduct the Business of the Association.

The purpose of Tuesday's **Leadership Team Meeting** was to discuss the **Missions Grant** program that was introduced at the April 24, 2023, Annual Meeting. David Timma, Moderator, presented an Application that each Church would use to request a *Missions Grant*, limited to up-to \$2,000 per person each year and up-to \$20,000 per Church each year. The Applications must be submitted at least 1 month in advance to the SBA Office, or the SBA Moderator, in order to be approved. The *Missions Grants* may also be used for Local Missions Projects here in Bedford County, as well as Missions Trips. A 6 month Financial Report was given by Lois Stevens, Treasurer, stating that we had \$71,453.87 in the Checking Account and a Total of \$159,179.84, with the CD's. Receipts were \$8,604.43 from 9 Churches. After discussion and a question and answer period, the Leadership Team Approved the Missions Grant Program to be Voted On at the next Annual Meeting.

The **Leadership Team** voted to approve the Next **Annual Meeting** is to be held again in the Spring, preferably sometime in April, but after Easter, and to be planned by the Admin Team. The **Leadership Team** approved the same **Annual Meeting** format that we used for the last couple of years. There will be a Catered Meal provided by the Association at 5:00 pm, followed a Business Session starting at 6:00 pm.

The **Leadership Team** also discussed **Centerfest**; which is scheduled for Saturday, Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. (4<sup>th</sup> Saturday) We need someone to serve as the Director, Facilitator, Supervisor, or Leader for **Centerfest** to coordinate the setting up and taking down of our SBA tent. In past years, the men of Trinity volunteered to handle setting up & taking down the Tent. However, these men are not able to help this year, so we need someone to step up to lead this **Missions & Ministry Opportunity**. The WMU also coordinated Volunteers for the Baby Changing Station and distributing bottled water that the Association provides. We do not have an associational WMU anymore, so maybe a Church WMU, or Women's Ministry group, could step up to serve at the baby-changing station. **Centerfest** is a wonderful Missions & Ministry Opportunity as an **Outreach Event** to our community as many visitors come to downtown Bedford each year. If you would like to Serve as **Centerfest Director**, or Volunteer, please let the SBA Office know as soon as possible.

The **Leadership Team** approved Vernon DeLong to serve as *Interim Secretary* for the Association after Joyce's Retirement. Vernon will be in the SBA Office 1 day a week, to check messages, return phone calls or whatever is needed. Vernon will also be responsible for the *Spirit*, our monthly Newsletter, so please send him your Church News. We want to *Communicate* to all the Churches what's happening in our Churches. Vernon also serves as Transitional Pastor at Pecks and is Vice-Moderator for SBA.
